Overview:

- Individuals who are incarcerated are not eligible for full Medicaid benefits.
- As of 2018, there is a limited Incarcerated benefit plan for incarcerated individuals that allows Health First Colorado (Colorado's Medicaid Program) to pay for inpatient service and those services related to the inpatient stay for incarcerated Health First Colorado eligible individuals who require 24-hours or more of inpatient hospital care.
- Upon release from incarceration, an individual may qualify for full health First Colorado benefits if they continue to meet eligibility criteria.
- Individuals contact the local human services in their county to update their status and inquire about Medicaid benefits.

Individual & Family Medicaid:

Colorado Medicaid is public health insurance for low-income Coloradans who qualify. You may be eligible based on your income.

- Clients who qualify for Health First Colorado may also qualify for Financial Assistance for food. The benefit amount awarded can range depending on the number of people in your household and your monthly expenses. Households with 1 individual can be awarded up to \$281 monthly.
