### **Child Care Assistance Programs (CCAP)**

- CCAP aids eligible, low-income Colorado families to apply for childcare services from birth to age 13 (or age 19 if the child has special needs or a disability and requires childcare).
- Each county establishes its own eligibility criteria and income guidelines. Please contact the Department of Human Services in your county of residence for more information or check your eligibility online at <a href="https://www.colorado.gov/PEAK">www.colorado.gov/PEAK</a>
  - o Applicants must agree to cooperate with Child Support Services
  - o Families can choose their own provider.

### **Colorado Shines**

- Childcare search engine provides a listing of child care and family care providers, including information about location, hours of operation, ages served, licensing, and if the provider accepts CCAP.
- Website also provides information about how to choose a safe, quality child care program, including how to do a licensing check, conduct a phone interview, request a tour, and check references.

### **Colorado's Universal Preschool Program**

- Application to Apply here
- Universal Preschool (UPK) Colorado ensures that every child in the year before they are eligible for kindergarten is eligible for half-day (15 hours), state-funded, voluntary preschool beginning in the 2023-24 school year.
- Three-year-olds with qualifying factors are eligible for part-time (10 hours) preschool programming.
  Families of children in the year before they are eligible for kindergarten with certain qualifying factors, are eligible for an additional 15 hours stacked on top of the half-day programming, bringing those children to full-day programming.
- UPK Colorado allows families to choose the right setting for their child, whether it is in a licensed community-based, school-based or home-based preschool setting.

- Childcare subsidy programs provide financial assistance to employees and military members who have children enrolled, or who will be enrolled, in licensed family care homes or childcare centers.
- Children must meet the following eligibility criteria:
  - Ages birth to 12 years of age (Exception: For the National Park Service children's ages must fit in the range of birth to 6 years).
  - Or, Disabled and under the age of 18.
