    - Available to Jefferson County residents and those experiencing homelessness that are facing financial challenges
    - Registration is required: Check website for registration times
    - Items needed: Photo ID, number receive when registered, arrive at pick-up time indicated when registering
    - Covid-19 safety precautions require you to pre-register and have appointment, wear masks, and drive slowly through the drive-thru

- You can only shop for your child(ren)!
- You MUST have a birth certificate for each child and your photo ID. NO EXCEPTIONS. This has been a requirement since 2010.
- If you have step-children, you must have proof that you are a step parent. Example: a copy of your marriage license and a copy of your spouses ID that matches the birth certificate for each child.
- You can only shop at your registered time, that you sign up for on December 1, 2023
- We will serve 3,500 children and each child will get a new toy from our main toy area
- Each child may receive 1 new toy, 1 small toy, 1 wooden toy car, and a stuffed animal.
- You will be given a survey to complete when you arrive at the event BEFORE you can shop.
- Our Denver event is one day and open to anyone in need, you do not need to live in Denver to attend. We will not have another event and our leftover toys will be given to nonprofit partners and schools.

- Denver Santa Claus Shop invites parents who are referred to DSCS from Denver Human Services, Social Service Agencies and Community Partners to Shop for toys for their children ages 0-11 in early December each year.
  - If you are a Denver resident and receiving assistance from Denver Human Services, your children ages 0 – 11 are automatically qualified for this year's toy distribution. If you are not receiving services from DHS, you need to be registered with and receiving assistance from some type of social service agency or community partner.
  - If you are a qualified Denver resident and have children ages 0-11, you may pre-register for the toy distribution by going to [denversantaclausshop.org](https://www.denversantaclausshop.org) and clicking on the "Registration" button. Registration typically opens mid-November.
