### OmniSalud

- OmniSalud is a program that provides undocumented Coloradans with a safe way to compare affordable health insurance plans and enroll on a secure online platform.
- This program is a safe option because you’ll be shopping and enrolling through Colorado Connect, a secure online platform that does not share information with any federal partners. You will not be asked for your immigration status when you apply for a health insurance plan through OmniSalud and enroll through Colorado Connect. Only information asked is name, address, and information about current income.
- The Open Enrollment Period is the time to sign up for a health insurance plan. Open Enrollment is November 1st, 2022 – January 15<sup>th</sup>, 2023
- To apply independently, start at Connect for Health Colorado’s website: <https://connectforhealthco.com/>
  - If you choose to share your information only with Colorado Connect, you’ll be directed to create an account with Colorado Connect on a separate application and enrollment site. When you do that, your information is stored separately from Connect for Health Colorado and is not shared with federal partners for any reason. **The information you provide when applying cannot be used for immigration enforcement.**
