- Connect with a dispatcher immediately:
 - o If you witness ICE activity in your community
 - o If you are unsure if ICE is operating in your area and want to confirm
 - o If past interaction with ICE needs documentation
- Share detailed information about location and situation
- Trained volunteers will be sent to the scene to:
 - o Record the event
 - o Identify participating ICE agents
 - o Remind those involved of their constitutional right

The Immigrant Legal Resource Center recommends the following if ICE is at your door:

- Do not open the door for ICE or any police officer without a signed warrant.
 - o The warrant must be signed by a judge with your specific and correct name and address on it.
 - o Ask them to slide the search warrant under the door or show you through a window to verify it is signed by a judge and has your correct name and address.
 - o If they do not have the correct information, you do not have to open the door!
 - o Contact the Colorado Rapid Response Network Hotline (1-844-864-8341) to report activity.
- You have the right to remain silent! Do not give personal information about yourself or anyone in your family.
- You have the right to refuse to sign anything before you talk to a lawyer.
- You have the right to speak to a lawyer and make a phone call.
 - o Make sure to memorize and carry phone numbers of who you would call in an emergency.

To Protect Yourself as an Immigrant:

4th Amendment

? Protects You From? →

Unlawful searches! ✕

You Can Say:

- "I do not give you my permission to enter my home, based on my 4th amendment rights under the United States Constitution."
- " I will only permit you to search my home if you show me a search warrant signed by a judge. If you have such a warrant, please tell me and slide it under the door."

5th Amendment

? Is the Right to...? →

Remain Silent! ✕

You Can Say:

" I do not wish to speak with you or answer your questions, based on my **5th amendment rights** under the United States Constitution"

6th Amendment

? Is the Right to...? →

Counsel! ✕

You have the **RIGHT** to seek legal advice , and the **RIGHT** to a trial!
