Report ICE Activity: Colorado Rapid Response Network Hotline 1-844-864-8341 (open 24/7)

- Connect with a dispatcher immediately:
  - o If you witness ICE activity in your community
  - o If you are unsure if ICE is operating in your area and want to confirm
  - o If past interaction with ICE needs documentation
- Share detailed information about location and situation
- Trained volunteers will be sent to the scene to:
  - Record the event
  - Identify participating ICE agents
  - Remind those involve of their constitutional right

<u>The Immigrant Legal Resource Center</u> recommends the following <u>if ICE is at your door:</u> <u>Resources for Prepardness Plan</u>

- Do not open the door for ICE or any police officer without a signed warrant.
  - The warrant must be signed by a judge with your specific and correct name and address on it.
  - Ask them to slide the search warrant under the door or show you through a window to verify it is <u>signed by a judget</u> and has your correct <u>name and address</u>.
  - o If they do not have the correct information, you do not have to open the door!
  - Contact the <u>Colorado Rapid Response Network Hotline</u> (1-844-864-8341) to report activity.
- You have the right to remain silent! Do not give personal information about yourself or anyone
  in your family.
- You have the right to refuse to sign anything before you talk to a lawyer.
- You have the right to speak to a lawyer and make a phone call.
  - Make sure to memorize and carry phone numbers of who you would call in an emergency.

Protects You From?

#### Q Unlawful searches!

#### You Can Say:

- "I do not give you my permission to enter my home, based on my 4th amendment rights under the United States Constitution."
- "I will only permit you to search my home if you show me a search warrant signed by a judge. If you have such a warrant, please tell me and slide it under the door."

## Q Remain Silent!

#### You Can Say:

"I do not wish to speak with you or answer your questions, based on my **5th amendment rights** under the United States Constitution"

# 6th Amendment



## Q Counsel!

You have the **RIGHT** to seek legal advice, and the **RIGHT** to a trial!
